Year 12 Applications

Applications are based on a personal statement, a copy of the student's most recent school report, mock or predicted grades, an interview with a member of the Sixth Form team and a supporting reference from the student's current school. All required documents should be sent to the Admissions Department by email to admissions@newhallschool.co.uk, or can be submitted with the Sixth Form Scholarship Application Form. Our entry requirements to Sixth Form are a minimum of three 7s and two 6s at GCSE, although certain subjects do carry individual grade requirements.

Scholarship & Award Applications

New Hall School offers scholarships and awards at Sixth Form entry. Preference may be given to boarders and Catholics, where candidates of a similar ability are being considered for scholarships. The school celebrates the honour of all scholarship achievements and students who win scholarships gain an important benefit in terms of public recognition, media coverage, school references, university admissions and job applications. There is a special provision for those identified as Most Able & Talented (MAT); scholars who are placed on the MAT Register are afforded additional target setting, monitoring and reporting.
